The Museum of Making Music believes that music is for everyone. The Gordon Grubbs Adult Music Scholarship supports adults (ages 21 and older) who wish to begin or return to music-making through the North Coast Strings orchestra program for violin, viola, cello, and bass.

This non-competitive program is designed to nurture learning, connection, and joy. Led by professional musicians, participants engage in weekly rehearsals, small-group coaching, and performance opportunities within a supportive and encouraging community.

Scholarships provide full program participation free of charge.

Scholarship Funding & Confidentiality

Scholarships are made possible through the generosity of our donors and are awarded based on demonstrated financial need. The application process is simple, confidential, and respectful. All income documentation is handled with care and securely destroyed after review or returned upon request.

Application Instructions

Step 1: Income Verification

Please select one verification method and attach the required documentation.

A. Expedited Verification

Applicants currently receiving assistance from county or state agencies have already completed income verification. We accept documentation from one of the following programs:

- Cash Aid
- CalFresh (Food Stamps)
- CalWORKs (Notice of Approval)
- Kin-GAP or Foster Care (Notice of Approval)
- Medi-Cal (Benefits Identification Card)
- WIC (Statement Letter or Voucher)
- HUD / Section 8 (Statement Letter)

Step 3: Statement of Understanding & Signature

- I understand that if continued assistance is needed, this application must be renewed twelve (12) months from the submission date.
- I certify that the information provided is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and that no additional income has been omitted. I agree to provide additional documentation if requested. I understand that scholarships are awarded based on financial need.
- If I must cancel my participation, I will notify the Museum of Making Music promptly so that funds may be reassigned. I understand that falsification of information or failure to submit required documentation may result in loss of eligibility.
- I acknowledge that by receiving scholarship support, the Museum of Making Music is committing to my learning experience. In return, I agree to attend at least two-thirds of scheduled rehearsals and to participate in all performances whenever possible.
